In this work, I tried to address the phenomenon of gender-based violence by focusing my attention on Tanzania, a country that I visited during a training internship carried out thanks to the "Ulisse" Student Mobility Program of the University of Sassari. In the first chapter, I outlined the complex economic, health and social situation in Tanzania, where women's emancipation still represents a hypothesis far from being accepted and implemented. In the second chapter, the various types of gender-based violence are defined and, through the narratives of the Tanzanian women whom I had the privilege of knowing during my stay in Pomerini, their difficulties are described, from birth, to childhood, to adolescence, until marriage and after reaching the old age.
